Clive Huntley

Enlistment address: 1 Wharf Road

World War One

Now Ballast Point Park, this is the registered address for Lieutenant Clive Nielson Huntley, who was aged 30, and a qualified engineer and draughtsman in the Department of Works in Sydney. He signed up and encourage a lot of his sapper mates to also sign up, to the 1st Field Company Division Engineers.

He faced direct combat on ANZAC Day at Gallipoli. He was wounded in action a couple of weeks later in on 3 May 1915 and died on the HS (Hospital Ship) Gascon on 4 May 1915. He was buried at sea between Gallipoli and Alexandria.
